He can't walk very far but he is going to the mission that they have. The blind man and his children are attending church.

The church gave clothes for the children. THIS IS THE BEST....You visited a house where the people were holding services for a cult church...Well, they are not having services there anymore because they got saved and are coming to the Christian church. Isn't all of this wonderful?

Brother Abel told me today that you would not believe the adults that are coming. Also, Mario said that he told him that you all were the first North Americans that had ever gone in there and it had gotten everyone's interest, that if North Americans were interested in that place, there must be something going on.

Also, Brother Julio Aguirre told me that a lot of people are coming to church at Los Tablones from the area where you worked there. I think he said that one of his members has a bus and they are coming on the bus.

All the reports have been good. I just talked to Stevie on the phone and he said, "Mama, that's what it is all about", and that's true.
